## Reminder- Power of Attorney for your 18 year old

Even if your student heads off to college with their insurance card in their wallet, and even if you're responsible for their medical bills, that doesn't mean you'll have instant and full access to working with their doctors if an emergency arises.

Talk with your lawyer about getting a "Healthcare Power of Attorney" and "General Power of Attorney" in place on your student so that they can get the help they need in an emergency. Attached is a sample Power of Attorney for SC but be sure to get one that is particular to your state.
